Online tool supporting rapid delivery of transport innovations

Summary of D1.5: "Rapid Delivery of Transport Innovations: State-of-the-Art Report and Interactive Online Tool"

One way FastTrack is helping local authorities speed up their roll-out of innovative mobility solutions is by collecting and sharing how other cities have already managed to speedily deploy innovations. We aim to help all local areas – and not only FastTrack cities – to be able to access and learn from these "State-of-the-Art" cases.

All of these cases are available in a searchable online database: <u>FastTrackMobility.eu/tool</u>. This database will be updated regularly throughout the FastTrack project.

The cases in the database specify: the nature of the location in question (urban, peri-urban, rural); how long it took to move from innovation concept to implementation; what was done and how; why this process successfully 'fast tracked' innovation deployment; lessons learnt; tips for replication; and links for more information.

In a deliverable report, FastTrack has also laid out how the interactive online tool is structured and the information contained within the case studies, to assist anyone to make use of or build on it. We explain how the information was gathered, and how it will aid FastTrack cities in their implementation of innovation, as well as how it can help other local areas in their own such work.

This deliverable is relevant to other local authorities, towns and cities, and anyone looking to increase how quickly they roll-out sustainable mobility innovations locally, thanks to its knowledge, advice, and inspiring examples. While our report explains the content of the interactive online tool, those interested in this information are encouraged to directly visit and make use of the tool to gain new information and insights into accelerating innovation.

The content that is most likely to be widely replicable are the tips contained within the cases, which make up the online tool.
